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
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



This, combined with an already thriving Arts District, makes North Hollywood a smart place to invest.



Located in the highly desirable San Fernando Valley, Valley Glen has emerged as one of Los Angeles' most attractive residential neighborhoods, offering the perfect balance of suburban tranquility and urban accessibility.
